Spot the Signs:

Modern slavery is real. It is an unseen crime hidden in our communities that is hard to spot if you don't know what you are looking for. Victims can be men, women and children of all ages.

Spot the Signs:



Victims may appear:

- · Malnourished and starved.
- Neglected and scruffy.
- · Unclean with poor hygiene.
- · Acutely tired and exhausted.
- To be drugged or drunk.
- To have incorrect clothing or equipment for the work they are doing.



Victims may appear:

- · Fearful or scared.
- · Anxious or stressed.
- · Angry or agitated.
- · Withdrawn.
- Traumatised



Victims may appear:

- Withdrawn.
- · Unable to communicate effectively.
- · Unable to understand you.
- · Unable to speak English.
- · To have someone else speak on their behalf.



Victims may appear to be living:

- · At a place of work.
- In an overcrowded house.
- · In a dilapidated caravan or outbuilding.
- In a place with blacked out windows.
- · With no heating or running water.
- · Somewhere clearly not fit to live in.

Restricted Freedom

Victims may appear:

- · Unable to come and go freely.
- Reluctant to leave their situation.
- Unable to find or show identity documents like a passport or bank account.

- In debt to, or dependent on someone else.
- Unwilling to handle money.

Victims may appear:

- · Reluctant to talk to you.
- · Reluctant to being helped by you or others.
- · Reluctant to leave their situation.
- · Fearful of you or authorities.
- · Fearful of reprisal from someone else.
- · Unable to prove their legal status to be in the UK.



Victims may appear to:

- · Travel at unusual times.
- · Travel very early in the morning or late at night.
- · Have transportation to and from work provided.
- · Have to pay for the transport.



Child victims may also appear to:

- Have mood swings.
- Be angry, upset or withdrawn.
- Show inappropriate sexual behaviour.
- Be dressed inappropriately for their age.

Domestic workers may be persuaded by force or threats to perform a range of tasks in a private house including cooking, cleaning, laundry and taking care of children. Victims often work very long hours including through the night for little or no pay. They are very difficult to spot because they may not be able to leave the house.

Sexual exploitation can involve individuals or gangs exploiting women, men or children. Women are often forced into prostitution, on the street or off the street in brothels, lap dancing bars or massage parlours. Men may be sexually exploited as a way of controlling them, making them too ashamed to contact the police or other authorities. Exploiters may coerce and control children to follow their wishes by regularly giving them presents, alcohol or drugs.

Forced Labour

Forced labour is any work or service which people are persuaded to do through force or threats such as the use of verbal or physical violence or intimidation, or by more subtle means such as to pay off a debt or taking away their identity papers and legal status. Threats may be aimed at them or their families. Victims are often men, forced to work long hours with no break and for little or no pay, but women and children are exploited in this way too. Victims may be well educated and can be found in many industries, but especially industries with low paid and low skilled workers. Victims may be transported to and from their place of work or even live at their place of work, often in poor conditions of health and safety and without appropriate protective clothing or safe equipment for the job.

Common signs of victims include:

- Inappropriate clothing or equipment for the job
- · Working long hours with no breaks
- Scared and frightened of employer or boss
- · Unwilling to handle money




