Cannabis Cultivation

- Organised Criminal Networks
- International operations
- Residential houses
- Hydroponic Equipment
- Est £70,000 per 3 months



Awareness on trafficking and re-victimisation

- NGO referrals
- Police
- Youth Detention Centres
- Media reports
- Scoping Assessment



P's Case

- 14 year old girl
- Clandestine entry
- Missing from Care
- Recovered from a farm
- Charged, prosecuted and sentenced
- Missing from Care



Findings

Children arrested for Cannabis Cultivation



Overview

- January 07 to January 08
- 42 cases (England and Wales)
- 39 children
- 10 to 18 years of age
- 34 males
- 4 females



Issues arising



Response

- Referral to Children's Services
- Arrested but not charged
- Initially charged but later withdrawn
- Arrested, charged and granted bail
- Arrested, charged and remanded in custody



Consequences

- Convictions and sentencing
- Re-offending
- Missing



Other details

- Entry/ Arrival to the UK
- Seeking Asylum
- Age disputes
- Family connections



Recommendations

- Victim Identification and Risk Assessment Protocols
 - Early
 - Protection
 - Screening
 - Age assessment
 - Translations
 - Monitoring

- Best Practice Guidelines
