What is the PolAd?

The Young Policy Advisers Course (PolAd) was developed in collaboration with the Folke Bernadotte Academy, and is designed to strengthen participants' knowledge of democratic institutions, and OSCE commitments in democratic governance, as well as facilitate a deeper understanding of the role of policy advisers and the skills needed to undertake key tasks and policy-making functions.

The PolAd aims to strengthen democratic institutions by building the capacity of young policy professionals

Eligibility Criteria

Public/civil professionals (up to age 35) currently working as policy or political advisers in the administration, line ministries, parliament or other state/public institutions in OSCE Mediterranean Partners for Co-operation, i.e. Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Morocco, or Tunisia, are invited to apply.

Course Costs

Tuition, course materials, full board accommodation, as well as round-trip travel costs to Florence, Italy will be covered by the organizers.
