### Addressing illicit financial flows and confiscating criminal assets



Strengthening the ability of participating States to implement the “follow the money” approach to deprive criminals of their financial power by limiting their ability to expand their operations and removing the incentive of financial gain.

### Strengthening prevention and fostering resilience



Strengthening the ability of criminal justice and civil society practitioners to disrupt recruitment and prevent youth involvement in crime through education, early identification of youth at risk and embedding a multi-stakeholder approach.
