## at the 925<sup>th</sup> session of the OSCE Permanent Council

Vienna, October 11, 2012

Mr. Chairperson,

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I would like to join other speakers in warmly welcoming the President of the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly, H.E. Riccardo Migliori. From the outset, I would like to pay tribute to the work carried out by the Parliamentary Assembly and its dedicated staff in Copenhagen for their perseverance and efforts in facilitating interparliamentary dialogue across the OSCE region.

I would also like to thank the Parliamentary Assembly in general and Mr. Migliori for his personal contribution to the international efforts aimed at providing comprehensive international monitoring of Georgia's parliamentary elections.

I am pleased to note that the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly in close cooperation with ODIHR contributed to further consolidation of democracy in Georgia through ensuring transparency of electoral process.
