**STATEMENT BY
THE PERMANENT DELEGATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS
TO THE OSCE AT THE 887th MEETING OF THE OSCE FORUM FOR
SECURITY CO-OPERATION**

20 June 2018

**On the completion of a joint project with the OSCE to dispose of
rocket fuel components**

Mr. Chairperson,

We should like to inform our esteemed colleagues about the completion of a joint project with the OSCE to dispose of liquid rocket fuel components (melange, samin and TM-185) in Belarus.

This project was carried out in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the Republic of Belarus and the OSCE, signed on 15 June 2015 by the Belarusian Minister of Defence and the OSCE Secretary General. The project resulted in the export of around 690 tonnes of hazardous chemicals from the territory of Belarus, which posed a serious threat to the population and the environment.

On 11 June, the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Belarus hosted an official ceremony dedicated to the completion of this project. Andrei Ravkov, Minister of Defence of Belarus, Ambassador Marcel Peško, Director of the Conflict Prevention Centre of the OSCE Secretariat, Christina Johannesson, Ambassador of Sweden to Belarus, and Sergei Ushakov, General Director of the Russian contracting company OOO NPF "Technoazot", took part in the event. As part of the ceremony, representatives of Belarus, the OSCE and the contracting company signed the final certificates on the completion of the project.

Taking this opportunity, we express our sincere gratitude to Ambassador Marcel Peško, the OSCE Secretariat and the contracting company for their support and excellent co-operation in the implementation of the project, and to Sweden for the allocation of funds without which its implementation would have been impossible.

We should also like to note that during the implementation of the project, Belarus consolidated concrete experience and effective practices, which it is ready to share with other countries that have similar problems with liquid rocket fuel components.

In conclusion, we reaffirm Belarus's readiness to co-operate constructively with the OSCE Secretariat and with other interested parties in the framework of joint projects in the Organization's politico-military dimension.
