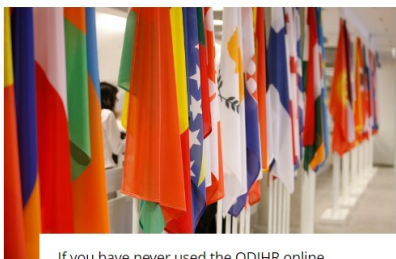

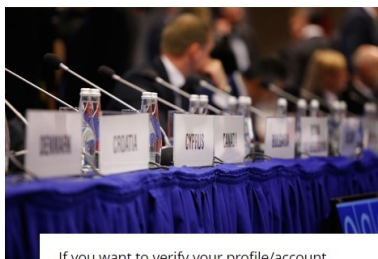

How to submit Documents

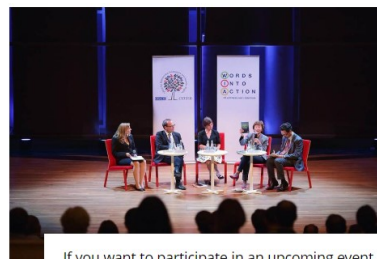
1. Any registered WHDC participant may submit documents on behalf of their delegation/organization. To submit documents, please visit <https://meetings.odihr.pl/> and login. Documents will be accepted one week prior to the conference until 14:00 CET on 31 October 2025.
2. After login, please click on “resources”.

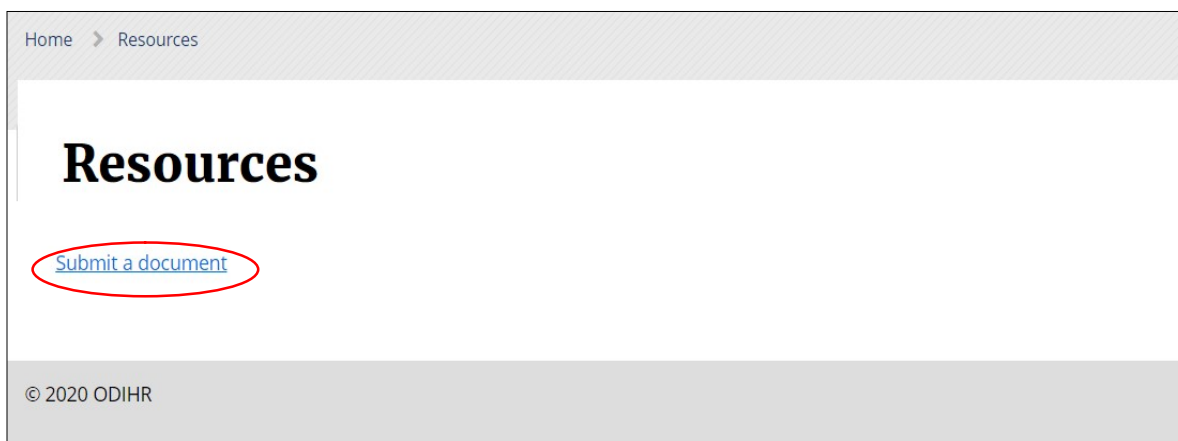

Additional guidance

Participants are encouraged to submit prepared texts at least 30 minutes before the relevant session to **facilitate greater accuracy of interpretation**.

Participants are also kindly requested not to use the logo of the WHDC 2025 on their documents but encouraged to **identify the author** in the title or letterhead of the documents they submit on their behalf.

If the author is not clearly identified in the submitted document or a participant is not the only author of the material (e.g., joint report prepared by multiple parties) a **disclosure** will be added: "Enclosed written contribution / information material is submitted by [NAME of Participant]".
