## **Provision of Internet Access and Ancillary Services to the OSCE**

The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (hereinafter referred to as "the OSCE") invites sealed proposals from qualified companies (hereinafter referred to as "the Bidders") for the provision of Internet access and ancillary services to the OSCE offices located in Vienna, Austria (hereinafter referred to as "the Services"), according to the requirements as defined in the Terms of Reference (hereinafter referred to as the "TOR").
