# 1. Meeting Venue



The conference will take place in the Hofburg Congress Centre in the Ratsaal conference room. The entrance to the centre, which is located on Heldenplatz, is shown on the map on the final page of this document. You will find an OSCE flag and the words "Hofburg Kongresszentrum" above the door.

Participant registration will take place on October 28, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. Participants are kindly reminded to bring appropriate identification for registration purposes.

## 2. Transportation from the Airport to Vienna City

<u>Taxis</u>: Taxis can either be hailed at the airport or can be booked in advance at a more moderate price from the company C&K (Tel: +43 1 44444 – price).

<u>City Airport Train (CAT):</u> The CAT can also be taken into the city centre of Vienna "Wien-Mitte" – Landstraße/Hauptstraße with access to the Underground (U-Bahn Line 3 and 4). <u>Bus Services:</u> There are also two Vienna Airport bus lines. These lines go either to Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz or to Südbahnhof/Westbahnhof (both stops provide access to the Underground). <u>Via Public Transport</u>: Trams 1, 2 and D all stop on the Ring, close to the Hofburg. The nearest stop is Burgring. The subway line U3 (the orange line) may also be taken. The closest station within walking distance is Herrengasse.
