> Interpretative statement under paragraph 79 (Chapter 6) of the Final Recommendations of the Helsinki Consultations

By the Delegation of Canada:

The Delegation of Canada made the following interpretative statement regarding the decision on improvement of the OSCE employment conditions:

"For the record, in Regulation 1.02, institutions to be eventually designated under paragraph e ['such other entities as may be designated as an OSCE Institution'] would, in the understanding of the Canadian Delegation:

1. have to request to be designated;

2. receive unanimous consent of the Permanent Council."
