Recommendations

The Right to a fair trial

1. To request from OSCE participating states courts report on the right to fair and public hearing ; judgment shall be pronounced publicly ; To collect data about the number of public and non-public court cases. To demand an explanation of the reasons for non-public court processes.
2. To oblige OSCE participating states to create law and draft law database on the Internet (on WEB-sites of the state bodies). This Web-page should have special frame for feedback for comments to draft laws .

The offer for ODIHR.

1. To begin the new project "The Law for All ", i.e. to create legislation to guarantee equal access for everybody; a legislation of direct action where laws as much as possible describe situations and have no variations for a judgment. One crime has only one variant judgment, alone punishment.
Such Law should be created in the form of a database by special computer program maintenance and in view of a case law .
