Recommendations

The Right to a fair trial

- 1. To request from OSCE participating states courts report on the right to fair and public hearing; judgment shall be pronounced publicly; To collect data about the number of public and non-public court cases. To demand an explanation of the reasons for non-public court processes.
- 2. To oblige OSCE participating states to create law and draft law database on the Internet (on WEB-sites of the state bodies). This Web-page should have special frame for feedback for comments to draft laws.

The offer for ODIHR.

1. To begin the new project "The Law for All", i.e. to create legislation to guarantee equal access for everybody; a legislation of direct action where laws as much as possible describe situations and have no variations for a judgment. One crime has only one variant judgment, alone punishment.

Such Law should be created in the form of a database by special computer program maintenance and in view of a case law.
