Downing of Ukraine International Airlines Flight PS752 by Iran

As delivered by Political Counselor Gregory Macris to the Permanent Council, Vienna January 16, 2020

Thank you, Mr. Chair.

The United States expresses its sincere condolences to those countries affected by Iran's downing of Ukrainian International Airlines flight PS752 on January 8. Iran must be held accountable, and we call on Iranian authorities to fully cooperate with investigations, including allowing international experts access to the flight data recorders (black boxes) without further delay. This tragic incident brings to mind another — that of Malaysian Airlines flight MH-17, which crashed in eastern Ukraine in 2014. We reiterate our strong support for the work of the Joint Investigation Team that thoroughly investigated the downing, and we will continue to offer all possible assistance to their efforts in bringing the perpetrators of this crime to justice. Russia must fully account for its role in the shootdown of MH-17.
