Information for Participants

1. Meeting Venue



The Centro Conferenze Internazionali “Alcide De Gasperi” is located at Via Pier della Francesca, n. 3 (in the building La Scuola Superiore di Polizia), Rome.

Participant registration will take place on September 12, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. Participants are kindly reminded to bring appropriate identification for registration purposes.

2. Getting around Rome: Taxi

Taxis can be found at designated areas and stands at the airport and train station, hailed or ordered by phone. Please be aware that if you call a taxi in Rome, the rate usually begins when the taxi is dispatched, not when it arrives.

Taxis to and from Rome's two airports have fixed fares by regulation. Rome taxi fares to or from Ciampino Airport should be around €30, including luggage. From Fiumicino Airport, the cost is approximately about €40. Taxis to and from the Termini station are not regulated.

It is recommended to use official taxis which are white, have a taxi sign mounted on the roof, have an insignia on the driver's door reading "*Comune di Roma*," have an official number and a meter.

3. Getting around Rome: Public transportation



The public transportation system in Rome is operated as an integrated system and public travel passes can be purchased from newsstands, tobacconists, or through vending machines at metro stations and major bus stops. Please note that drivers do not sell tickets. 1 and 3 day passes are available.

The Rome Metro Underground Train system has just two lines named A and B. The lines intersect at Rome Termini Station, the main public transport hub in Rome. Trains run approximately every 4-10 minutes, from 5:30am until 11:30pm every day (until 12:30am on Saturdays).

Rome public buses run a very comprehensive and frequent system running from about 05:30 to midnight daily. These bus services are supplemented by night services that run all night along the core routes.

From the Airport to Centro Alcide De Gasperi: Take the direct train 'Leonardo Express' to Roma Termini Central Station. For more information about train times and prices, please refer to <http://www.trenitalia.com>

Upon arrival to Termini Central Station, take the Metro A (in the direction of the Battistini Station) and get off at the Flaminio Station. Exit the station and from the Piazzale Flaminio, get on the fast tram no. 2 (in the direction of Piazza Mancini). Get off at the Centro Alcide De Gasperi.

From Roma Termini Central Station to Centro Alcide De Gasperi: See above
