The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe invites applications from eligible and qualified companies for pre-qualification for the purpose of entering into a corporate window contract for the supply and delivery of IT security hardware and software and provision of maintenance services, according to the requirements as defined in the documents attached hereto.
