Short biography

Dr. Grigoriy Perepelytsia is Director of the Foreign Policy Research Institute of Diplomatic Academy at the Ukrainian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He graduated from the Higher navy school, the Defense Academy and holds a Ph.D in political sciences. He served as chief of analytical group at the Centre for Strategic Studies of the General Staff of Ukrainian Armed Forces; head of military policy department at the National Institute for Strategic Studies; deputy director of National Institute for Strategic Studies, director of the Foreign Policy Research Institute, a professor of the Institute of International Relations at the Kiev National University. Dr. Perepelytsia is known in Ukraine and abroad as expert on foreign and security policies. He has authored over 50 publications.
