What is the Model OSCE?

The **Model OSCE** is a four-day event (provisional dates: 15-18 September 2016):

Day 1: Take part in team-building exercises led by an OSCE trainer and learn more about the OSCE from OSCE officials

Day 2 and 3: Receive essential negotiation skills training from an international OSCE expert

Day 4: Participate in the Model OSCE simulation game

The Model OSCE simulation game reproduces the OSCE Permanent Council during a crisis situation. Participants will each represent an OSCE participating State and will work together to resolve the crisis.

Three of the best students in the Model OSCE will be invited to attend an OSCE Permanent Council meeting in the OSCE Secretariat in Vienna

The Model OSCE is free of charge. Accommodation, transportation and meals will be provided for the duration of the event.

All students who successfully complete the Model OSCE will be awarded a certificate issued by the OSCE Mission to Moldova.

- ✓ Background in Law, International Relations, Political Sciences or Journalism
