The Recommendations of the Office for Kosovo and Metohija of the Republic of Serbia regarding the Center for Peace and Tolerance in Pristina

Strongly supports the OSCE Mission in Kosovo in its efforts to help the remaining forty Serbs in Pristina retain this last 30 m2 of premises of the Center for Peace and Tolerance (CPT) in Pristina;

Invite KFOR and UNMIK to act upon previous notices about the CPT issue sent by the Office for Kosovo and Metohija of the Republic of Serbia, and actively involve and exert appropriate powers to prevent the Kosovo Police Service' plans to close down the CPT as well as any potential plans for relocating this Center to some less convenient and less safe premises;

Strongly support adequate and tangible measures be taken by all relevant international presences and missions in Kosovo to substantially - not only formally - improve freedom of movement in Kosovo by means of upgrading the security level for all people, and in particular for the threatened communities;

Reconfirm that no measures can be taken by local actors, or tacitly or expressly accepted by international presences and missions in Kosovo, that substantially hamper and/or limit the freedom of movement or security of Serbs.
