- Both the <u>Technical</u> and the <u>Financial</u> Bid must be submitted **separately** and in sealed envelopes, clearly separately marked <u>"Technical Bid"</u> and <u>"Financial Bid"</u>.
- To ensure timely international delivery, bids can alternatively be sent electronically to the confidential email address <u>tenders.MK@osce.org</u> (but must be followed up by hardcopy by regular mail / courier).
- Bids by fax will not be accepted.
- All Bid prices shall be quoted in Euro, free of duties and VAT.
- Partial Bids will <u>not</u> be accepted.
