Section II – SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS

Project Title

Adaptation and Localization of California Psychological Inventory (CPI 462) with the Georgian population and establishing its norms.

Background

The Georgian Ministry of Internal Affairs requested OSCE assistance in the field of Human Resources Management for bringing personnel management into alignment with international standards. The recruitment process serves as the starting point of any Human Resources Management organization, and should be reformed with a view to ensuring a transparent and democratic personnel system. Contemporary and progressive recruitment procedures include psychometric tests that measure personal attitudes and aptitudes and provide necessary feedback.

In order to ensure a reliable selection of suitable candidates for every branch and level of the Georgian police force, the OSCE Mission, in partnership with local professional psychologists, has begun the preparations for introducing psychometric testing. As a psychometric test CPITM 462 will prove to be the most reasonable instrument for the use of the Georgian police.

Effective psychometric test will help selection makers to find well-fitted candidates for the job based on psychological capacities and values. However these tests should reflect Georgian culture and history, therefore they should be adapted and localized into the Georgian cultural and language environment.

The Mission's task also includes instituting a structured interview as one tool in a transparent selection process, for which special trainings and workshops for MIA policymakers and the heads of the central departments and regional units of Georgian Police is provided.

Requirements:

The bidder should:

- 1. determine the part of the population which will be the subject of the adaptation;
- 2. overview the existing Georgian version of the Inventory (will be provided) and prepare it for the determined population, to do item analyses with the trial data: checking that items correlate with the scales they are supposed to.
- 3. conduct the psychometric analysis of inventory provisions after using it for selection.
- 4. elaborate the final version of the Inventory.
- 5. establish the norms of personal characteristics that can be measured according to the Inventory.
- 6. prepare the electronic version of the Inventory.

Terms for the Participating in Tender:

- Non-governmental organization and higher educational institution has a right to participate in the tender;
- The participant should have at least 3 year experience of establishing norms and adaptation of psychological tests in Georgia.

Additional Requirements:

The bidder should:

- provide a General information on establishment, activities, similar projects undertaken.
- prices for the service (price-list); (<u>Notes to Bidders</u>: It is mandatory that the Bidder duly completes and signs the Quotation Submission Form, Section I or alternatively, ensures that its contents are duly copied onto its standard corporate quotation form).

Hard copies of:

- an extract from the Register of non-entrepreneurial legal entities;
- a taxpayer's certificate.

Companies should provide a scanned or hard copy of:

- a court resolution on registration (state registration document);
- an extract from the Entrepreneurial Register (state registration document);
- a taxpayer's certificate; and
- a VAT-payer's certificate (if applicable), or a notice from the tax inspection that the Contractor is not registered as a VAT-payer.
