Please find attached the agenda and general guidelines relating to the upcoming OSCE Supplementary Human Dimension Meeting on Freedom of Movement and Human Contacts. This Meeting will take place in Vienna from 25th to 26th April 2013.

This Supplementary Human Dimension Meeting (SHDM) seeks to address how the right to freedom of movement can be advanced and protected and how further progress could be achieved in facilitating cross-border human contacts. It will identify the challenges OSCE participating States currently face and discuss how they can be addressed, in order to ensure the full enjoyment of freedom of movement in the OSCE region. With the aim to explore possibilities for creating conditions for freer cross border movement, the SHDM will discuss on-going visa facilitation and liberalization dialogue between OSCE participating states, their impact on cross border mobility, and how new technologies and innovative approaches could be used to facilitate the processing of requests for entry into territories of OSCE participating States.

The meeting will address the topic through the following three sessions:

- OSCE commitments on freedom of movement and challenges to their implementation;
- Benefits of cross-border human contacts and strengthening co-operation among OSCE participating States in this field;
- Innovative approaches to facilitate cross-border mobility in the OSCE region.

Civil society representatives whose activities directly relate to the topic of the SHDM and who wish to attend are requested to register on-line at <u>http://meetings.odihr.pl</u> by **Wednesday**, **17** April **2013**. The registration will also be available online after the deadline and during the Meeting on the spot. Civil society representatives are invited to forward this information to other relevant actors in the given field.

Participants may display information materials on the tables in the lobby of the main meeting room. Participants are encouraged to intervene during the SHDM Working Sessions while limiting their statements to the specific issues at hand thereby contributing to a genuine discussion.
