The U.S. delegation would like to take this opportunity to invite our esteemed colleagues to visit our exhibition “Headlines of History: Remembrance and Resilience,” displayed here in the Congress Center’s Vorsaal.

The exhibition commemorates the victims of the 9/11 terrorist attacks and includes reproductions of front pages from American and international newspapers on September 12, 2001.

The exhibition also features more recent photos highlighting the resilience of the affected communities, and depicts examples of impromptu and permanent memorials to the deceased.
