





- Intersectoral and transboundary trade-offs and externalities may cause friction
- Forming a holistic picture of situation is complicated
 - and look into the future too!
- Need to find balance between various uses and protection of the resource
 - address trade-offs and increase synergies
- Need to coordinate policies, plans & management measures between the riparian countries
 - to avoid negative impacts from unilateral action
- More opportunity for benefits looking at the basin as a whole, only achievable through joint action
