Special focus in video and in audio materials was paid to the registration for voting of **internally displaced persons from Crimea and Donbas**

TRAININGS FOR JUDGES

- ✓ More than **400 administrative and local court judges** trained.
- ✓ Main focus: strengthening the capacity of the judiciary to review **election-related disputes** in compliance with **the international standards** and **the case-law of the ECHR** relevant to voting rights.
