EU Statement on the death of Kateryna Handzyuk

Ukrainian activist Kateryna Handzyuk passed away on 4 November as a result of an acid attack on 31 July outside her home in Kherson, Ukraine. Kateryna Handzyuk was a courageous and dedicated activist focusing on the fight against corruption in Ukraine. We offer our condolences to her family and friends.

We expect the Ukrainian authorities to make every effort to swiftly and thoroughly investigate Kateryna Handzyuk's murder. We echo the calls of the Representative on Freedom of the Media and of the Director of ODIHR to bring those behind this terrible crime to justice. Furthermore, we look forward to tangible steps to be taken to reverse the worrying trend of attacks against civil society activists and investigative journalists in Ukraine.

A vibrant civil society is crucial in any democratic society, and it is of utmost importance that this is protected – in Ukraine as elsewhere.
