Transitional Justice Seminar in Vrnjačka Banja:

“Dealing with the Past: An Introduction to Transitional Justice with a Special Focus on War Crimes Trials and the Relevant Jurisprudence of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) and the International Court of Justice (ICJ)”

Location: Vrnjačka Banja

Date: 1 - 4 July 2019

The seminar is intended for graduate and postgraduate students from across Serbia, and youth involved in political parties, public administration, media and civil society organizations.

The seminar will cover the following topics:

- Introduction to transitional justice mechanisms;
- Truth commissions;
- Reparations;
- The International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) and the International Court of Justice (ICJ), with a special focus on cases dealing with Srebrenica;
- National war crimes trials;
- Crimes based on gender and sexual violence in armed conflict.

The lecturers will include national and regional experts in transitional justice, history, international public law, international humanitarian law, and international criminal law.

The OSCE Mission to Serbia will cover the costs of transportation, accommodation and meals. Applicants currently residing in Serbia are eligible to apply.
