**DECISION No. 1/07**  
**USE OF THE OSCE COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK**  
**TO SUPPORT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ARTICLE IV OF**  
**THE DAYTON PEACE ACCORDS**

The Forum for Security Co-operation (FSC),

Recalling section II, subsection (A), paragraph 2 of the OSCE Communications Network Document, annexed to FSC.DEC/5/99 of 6 October 1999, according to which the FSC will consider proposals of other OSCE-related bodies to enhance their use of the Network,

Reaffirming the importance of the Network for the successful implementation of agreements and treaties,

Welcoming the request of the Personal Representative of the OSCE Chairman-in-Office for Article IV, Annex 1-B, Dayton Peace Accords for use of the Network by the Personal Representative's office, the Parties to the Agreement, and the OSCE Mission to Bosnia and Herzegovina,

Decides:

- To approve the use of the Network for implementation of the Dayton Peace Accords;
- To task the Communications Group with the technical implementation of this decision, contingent upon the receipt of the necessary resources from the Office of the Personal Representative.

**DECISION No. 2/07**  
**SUMMARY REPORT ON RECENT TRENDS IN THE**  
**IMPLEMENTATION OF THE VIENNA DOCUMENT 1999 AND**  
**OTHER MEASURES ADDRESSED DURING THE ANNUAL**  
**IMPLEMENTATION ASSESSMENT MEETING**

The Forum for Security Co-operation (FSC),

Recalling the importance of the Vienna Document 1999,

Recalling that the FSC has decided that the Annual Implementation Assessment Meeting (AIAM) will be held on 6 and 7 March 2007 in Vienna (FSC.DEC/8/06),

Recalling the papers prepared by the co-ordinators for the AIAM in 2004–2006 on the implementation of the Vienna Document 1999 on the basis of the yearly overview drawn up by the Conflict Prevention Centre (CPC),

Recognizing that a report on trends in the implementation of the Vienna Document 1999 might enhance discussion in the AIAM on 6 and 7 March 2007 and promote motivation to further the implementation of the Vienna Document 1999,

Decides to request the CPC to prepare a summary report on recent trends in the implementation of the Vienna Document 1999 and other measures addressed during the AIAM. The report will be limited to the provision of statistical data related to implementation and will not compare national policies or assess implementation. The report should be made available to the participating States not later than 15 February 2007. This task will be completed within the existing CPC budget. In future years, the report will be provided three weeks before the holding of the AIAM.
