Please find attached the agenda and general guidelines relating to the upcoming OSCE Supplementary Human Dimension Meeting on Rule of Law in the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights. This Meeting will take place in Vienna from 11 to 12 July 2013.

This Supplementary Human Dimension Meeting (SHDM) will provide a forum to discuss how the rule of law in the promotion and protection of human rights can be enhanced in the OSCE area. Participants will discuss the role of legislative, regulatory and institutional frameworks as well as governments and civil society in the promotion and protection of human rights. With respect to effective national and international instruments to protect human rights and prevent human rights violations, participants in this SHDM will identify best practices, current challenges and solutions. They will also explore means for strengthening the rule of law in the promotion and protection of civil, political, social, economic and cultural rights.

The meeting will address the topic through the following three sessions:

- The Role of Legislative, Regulatory and Institutional Frameworks as well as Governments and Civil Society in the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights;
- Effective National and International Instruments to Protect Human Rights and Prevent Human Rights Violations: Best Practices, Current Challenges and Solutions;
- Strengthening the Rule of Law in the Promotion and Protection of Civil, Political, Social, Economic and Cultural Rights.

The registration will also be available online after the deadline and during the Meeting on the spot. Civil society representatives are invited to forward this information to other relevant actors in the given field.

Participants are encouraged to intervene during the SHDM Working Sessions while limiting their statements to the specific issues at hand thereby contributing to a genuine discussion.
