EU Statement on the Shooting at the Jewish Museum in Brussels

The European Union would like to draw the attention of the Permanent Council to the statement by the EU High Representative on the 24 May 2014 concerning the shooting at the Jewish Museum in Brussels:

"I condemn unreservedly the dreadful attack today at the Jewish Museum in Brussels. I send my condolences to the families of the victims and express my solidarity with the Belgian authorities and the Jewish community.

Everything possible must be done to find those who carried out this attack. There must be no impunity for terrorism."

The Candidate Countries the FORMER YUGOSLAV REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA*, MONTENEGRO*, ICELAND+ and SERBIA*, the Countries of the Stabilisation and Association Process and Potential Candidates ALBANIA and BOSNIA and HERZEGOVINA, and the EFTA countries LIECHTENSTEIN and NORWAY, members of the European Economic Area, as well as UKRAINE, the REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA, ARMENIA, GEORGIA, ANDORRA, MONACO and SAN MARINO align themselves with this statement.
