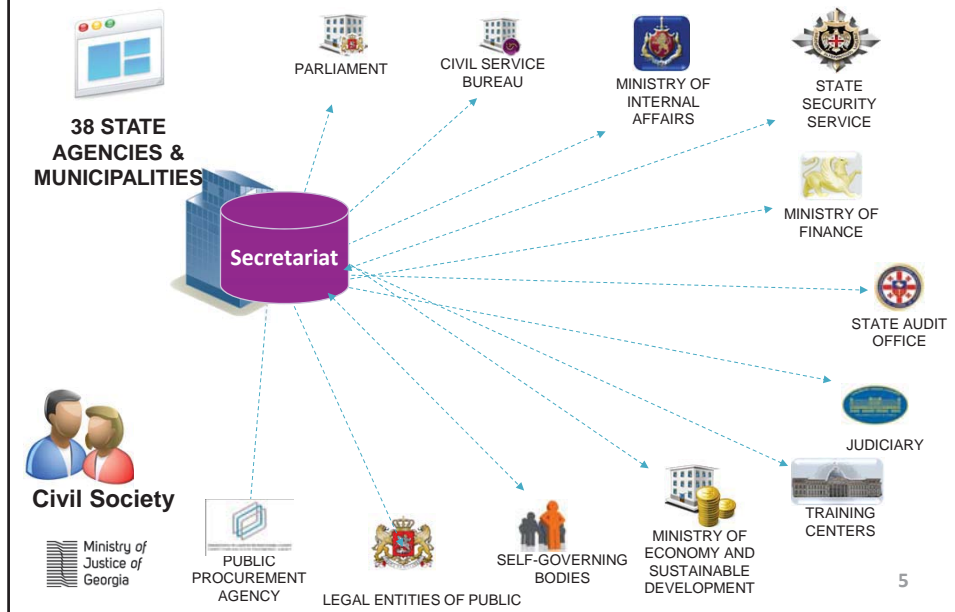

Anti-Corruption Reforms: Innovations and e-governance solutions

- **Single Portal of E-services - www.my.gov.ge**
A digital single point of contact and a digital front-desk for e-service delivery of public agencies. It provides all services on one platform and allows citizens to interact with the government.
- **Georgian Electronic Government Procurement System (Ge-GP System)**
An e-Procurement system fully replaced paper-based tenders. The Ge-GP System has become the single platform. It ensures an open, transparent and competitive environment for any person interested in participating in the public procurement procedures at all stages of the public procurement process.
- **Citizen Participation in Supervision of Public Finances – Budget Monitor**
An analytical web-platform providing comprehensive information about state and municipal budgets, audit findings and recommendations. It delivers important information to citizens efficiently and encourages them to participate in monitoring of public administration



Anti-Corruption Reforms: Innovations and e-governance solutions (Continued)

- **Asset declarations for public officials - www.declaration.gov.ge**
All senior public officials of Georgia are required by the Law to submit asset declarations electronically. Additionally, asset declarations monitoring system has been established with the primary goal is to increase transparency and trust of citizens in public administration by monitoring disclosed information on assets of public officials as well as to prevent conflicts of interest and promote integrity within public institutions.
- **On-line civil service recruitment portal – www.hr.gov.ge**
Public institutions are required to place civil service vacancy announcements on www.hr.gov.ge. Any job seeker has an opportunity to register on the website for free, build his/her resume, browse the vacancies and apply online. In addition, job seekers are able to ask questions directly to the employment providers online.



Anti-Corruption Reforms: Innovations and e-governance solutions (Continued)

- **I-change – e-petitions portal**

An e-petition platform that enables every citizen to create an electronic petition on issues within the competence of the Georgian government. Petitions that manage to gather a minimum of 10,000 signatures within 30 days will be considered by a special Commission set up in the Government Administration.

- **Open Data Portal – www.data.gov.ge**

The Portal enables to increase the accessibility of open data, support the development of e-services and e-applications, stimulate business activities, increase public sector transparency and its accountability.

- **Voice of the Customer**

A feedback system allowing customers to directly participate in improving the service quality of the Public Service Hall and to receive feedback from the PSH

- **Registration of services into the Blockchain**

Georgia is the first Government which secures land titles on the Bitcoin
