## Victims of Trafficking in Persons

Identifying the victim at contact points and control



Consultation



Request for protection from the victim, etc. (seeking shelter at police boxes, etc.)



Protection by the Police, Immigration Bureau, Women's Consultation Offices, NGOs, Embassies in Japan



Temporary protection by Women's Consultation Offices



Temporary protection by private-sector shelters, etc.

- Conduct counseling and consultation activities
- Conduct flexible operation of immigration control-related procedures
- Rescue victims through flexible operation of special permission for residence
  - Ensure the safety of victims



Assistance for repatriation of victims

- Repatriation assistance through the IOM
- Repatriation assistance by repatriating victims at government expense
- Repatriation assistance through coordination with agencies concerned
