**Background:** the OSCE Project Co-ordinator in Ukraine with the financial support of the donor countries within the framework of the “Building Ukrainian Humanitarian Mine Action Capacity” project supports Ukraine’s capacity for humanitarian demining of territories affected by the explosive remnants of war.
