Statement of the European Union on the Russian Invitation to ODIHR to observe the forthcoming Parliamentary Elections

Mr Chairman,

the European Union greatly regrets that ODIHR was not able to determine how to observe the forthcoming elections in the Russian Federation and then, through delay, could not observe them as they might have judged appropriate. We are concerned that there was a delay in issuing an invitation to ODIHR which included unprecedented restrictions. As ODIHR considers the invitation we hope that all practical arrangements will be facilitated expeditiously, and that observers will be given unfettered access to the entire electoral process.
