In August, Coalitions against Hate from Prijedor and Teočak presented the new Community Cohesion Action Plans to local authorities and citizens in over 30 multiethnic local communities. These aim to encourage citizens and decision-makers alike to help bias-motivated incidents, the spread of hate speech on social networks, and offensive graffiti.
