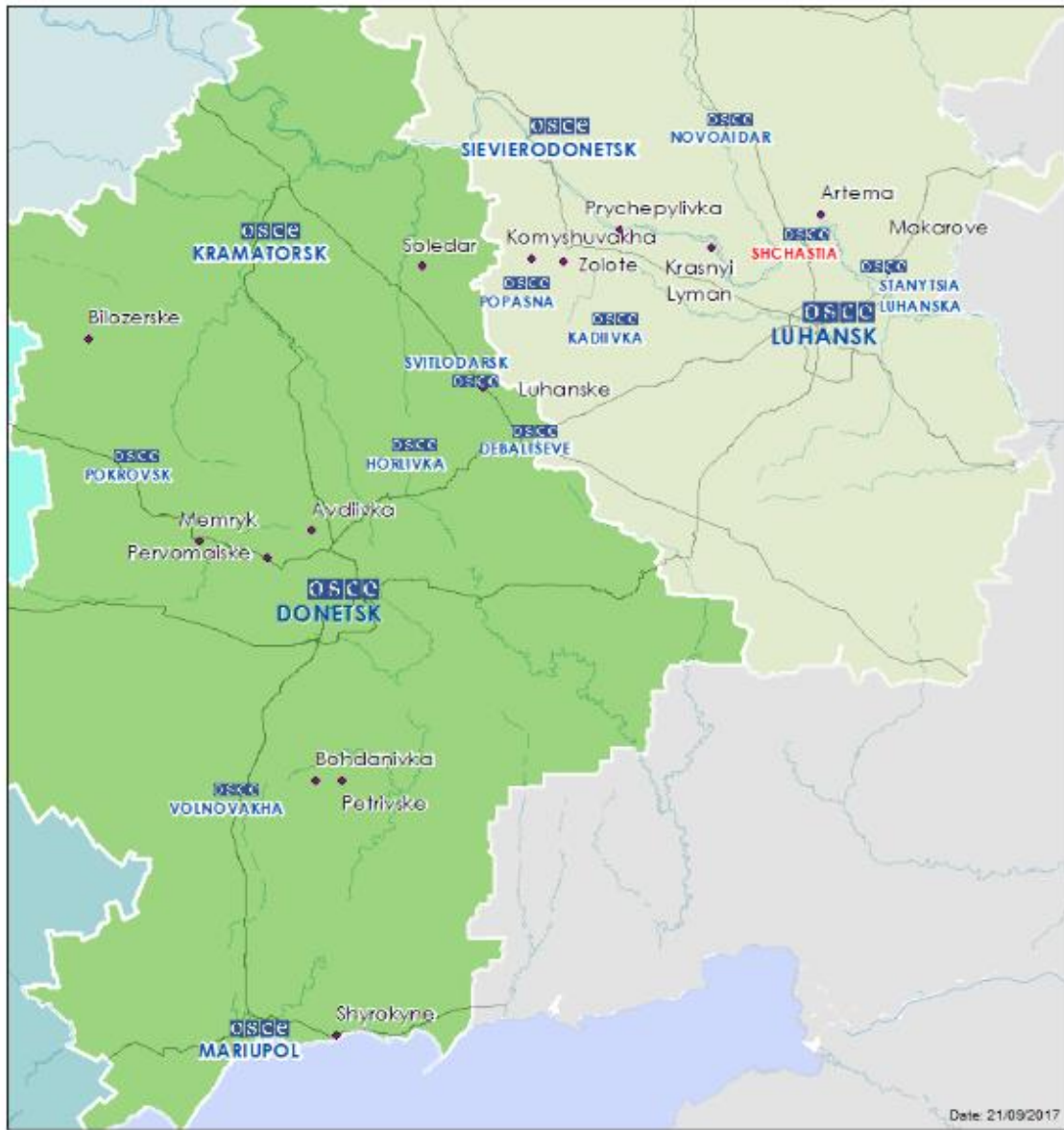

Ceasefire violations recorded by more than one patrol and assessed to be the same are entered only once.

(In red: forward patrol base from which SMM staff has temporarily relocated since 27 September 2016 based on recommendations of security experts from participating States.)
