GRANT SCHEME FOR INTER MUNICIPAL COOPERATION 2008

Report on Evaluation Results

The selection panel in charge of evaluating proposals submitted under the OSCE SMMS Public Administration Reform Department grant scheme for inter municipal cooperation completed its screening on 14 July 2008. The Panel was composed of the following five members:

1. Aqim Emurli (OSCE), Chairman;
2. Maja Subotic (OSCE), Member;
3. Zage Filipovski (OSCE), Member;
4. Rahim Musliu (MoSLG), Member; and
5. Gordana Milosevic-Jurukovska (UNDP), Member

Out of ten proposals received, three applications did not meet the administrative requirements contained in the grant scheme guidelines and were excluded from further evaluation. The remaining applications were appraised in line with the criteria outlined in the quoted guidelines, and ranked in the following order:

1. Lipkovo
2. Ohrid
3. Delcevo
4. Ceginovo-Oblesevo
5. Kocani
6. Novo Selo
7. Bitola
8. Veles *
9. Rosoman **
10. Dojran ***

Given the quality of the projects, a fourth grant was added to the three originally planned. Four projects (from number 1 to number 4) will therefore receive funding. All interested applicants can receive their individual evaluation results by sending an email to Mr. Aqim Emurli, Aqim.Emurli@osce.org. Applicants of the selected proposals will be contacted by OSCE SMMS Public Administration Reform Department representatives; the OSCE shall conclude an agreement with the first 4 selected consortia. The OSCE retains the right of modifying selected project proposals before entering into contractual agreements with the leading municipalities of the consortia.
