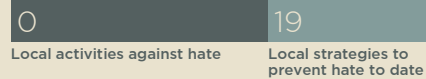

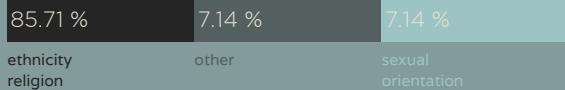

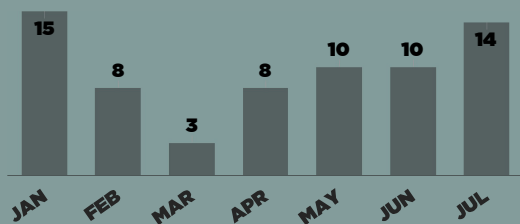

In July, 32 representatives of CSOs from across BiH attended a series of three online workshops on social cohesion monitoring. In these sessions, the participants were introduced to instruments for monitoring the quality of social cohesion, including the gathering, presentation, and visibility of data, alongside the use of new technologies.
