Background to Cyprus

- The third largest island in the Mediterranean, 1 million people
- Significant geo-political location.
- An independent republic in 1960 Greek & Turkish Cypriots share political equality
- Inter-ethnic conflict breaks out in December 1963 Turkish Cypriots forced out of power
- Turkey intervenes July 1974 following a Greekbacked coup in Cyprus. The island is divided into two ethnic zones
- ◆ 2004 referenda on UN unification plan: 65% Turkish Cypriots vote "yes", 76% Greek Cypriots vote 'no'
- ♦ Both sides have suffered enormous trauma due to conflict – its negative fallout continues to be felt 44 years after its outbreak



Living Under Embargoes

While Greek Cypriots have been able to rebuild their lives, Turkish Cypriots (TCs) continue to live under international isolation

- ◆ Daily discrimination: direct trade, travel & communication with rest of world is denied – everything must go via Turkey or South Cyprus – making everything take longer and cost more
- ♦ North Cyprus' GDP one third of South Cyprus
- TC political representation barred at UN, EU etc; only Greek Cypriots have a voice
- ◆ Traditional industries such agriculture are crippled (50% of fresh produce, such as lemons, rot away due to lack of buyers)
- Students face education embargo as North Cyprus institutions and diplomas not recognised under Bologna Process
- ◆ TCs banned from taking part in international sports such as the World Cup and Olympics (incl. under the Olympic flag!) – even friendly football matches are not permitted
