European Union statement on parliamentary elections in

Turkmenistan

The EU has taken note of the *Mejlis* parliamentary elections in Turkmenistan

that took place on 14 December 2008.

The EU welcomes the fact that international observers were invited to monitor

elections and that an OSCE/ODIHR Election Support Team was deployed to

Turkmenistan in the context of the dialogue established in early 2007 between

the authorities of Turkmenistan and the OSCE/ODIHR on possible

improvements to the electoral process in line with OSCE commitments.

The EU has taken note of the ODIHR's Needs Assessment Mission Report of 20

October 2008, which concludes, inter alia, that the current political context

does not allow for a meaningful competition. Therefore, the EU encourages

cooperation between the relevant Turkmen authorities, the OSCE Center in

Ashgabat, and the ODIHR on election related issues in the future in order for

Turkmenistan to comply with OSCE commitments in this field, particularly

those enshrined in the 1990 Copenhagen Document and which relate to

political pluralism, election campaign and voting and counting procedures.
