The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (hereinafter referred to as "the OSCE") invites sealed proposals from qualified companies (hereinafter referred to as "the Bidders") for the provision of Secondary Internet Service Provider Services to the OSCE Secretariat (hereinafter referred to as "the Services") in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Request for Proposal Document (hereinafter referred to as "the RFP Document).

The duration of the proposed contract will be for a period of one year with a possibility of four annual extensions, up to a maximum aggregate duration of five (5) consecutive years.
