Media are invited to attend the following activities in various parts of Kosovo:

OSCE Regional Centre in Prishtinë/Priština organized events:

- 1. An open day sessions will be organized on 15 September at 10.00 in the following municipalities: Podujevë/Podujevo, Shtime/Štimlje, Gllogovc/Glogovac, Fushë Kosovë/Kosovo Polje and Gračanica/Graçanicë. Youth assembly members and NGOs' representatives will distribute booklets that present the structure of municipal assembly and short profile of the municipalities after the session.

Simulation of the Municipal Assembly Session by former Youth Assembly members and secondary schools' students will be organized on 15 September, in the Municipal Assembly Hall in Suharekë/Suva Reka at 12.30. OSCE representatives, mayor, municipal director of economy and finance and other officials are expected to participate.
- 5. Roundtable discussion on "Women in Democracy-Challenges and Opportunities" will be organized on 15 September, in the Municipal Assembly Hall in Rahovec/Orahovac, at 13.00. Approximately 80 women of different communities are expected to participate.

- 2. Regular municipal assembly session will host 24 secondary school students and discuss about democracy and youth. The event will be organized on 15 September, in the cultural house in Viti/Vitina at 10.00. Municipal open door day and a presentation on the legislative branch will be organized on 15 September in the Viti/Vitina municipal building, at 10.00.
- 3. Question and answer session will be organized on 15 September in the Gjilan/Gnjilane Municipal Assembly Hall, with a panel of legislative and executive officials for local students, at 11.00.
- 4. Policy and Finance Committee meeting will host five Kosovo Serbs and five Kosovo Albanians with an in-door visit to the municipality of Štrpce /Shtërpcë on 15 September at 10.00.
- 5. Essay competition on the meaning of democracy for secondary school students with participation of approximately 200 students will be organized on 15 September, in the Kamenicë/Kamenica Municipal Assembly Hall at 11.00. Municipal open door day with a presentation on the legislative branch will also be organized on 15 September, in the same municipality, starting from 11.00.
- 6. Painting competition on democracy for Youth Assembly members and young civil society members will be organized jointly with the municipal human rights unit, on 15 September, in the Kaçanik/Kačanik Municipal Assembly Hall at 12.00. Representatives of OSCE, informal women's caucus members and municipal officials are expected to attend.
- 7. Lessons on democracy and good governance to be held simultaneously in ten schools across the municipality in Ferizaj/Uroševac. Guest speaker will be Professor Esat Stavileci from Prishtinë/Priština Law Faculty and will give lecture on international and local perspective on democracy on 15 September in the Ferizaj/Uroševac Municipal Assembly Hall at 10.00.
