EU Statement on the Adoption of the Declaration on Afghanistan

Thank you Mr. Chairman,

We welcome the adoption of this declaration. It underscores this Organisation's commitment to contributing to Afghanistan's success as it navigates its ongoing security, political, and economic transitions, and it reconfirms our interest in a democratic future for the people of Afghanistan in a stable and secure State. We, too, had of course hoped to be able to adopt a more substantial declaration on Afghanistan at the Ministerial Council in Kyiv. A more substantial declaration would have reflected the full range of our cooperation with this important partner State and it would also have highlighted - despite continuing challenges - the important progress made in Afghanistan in recent years.
