Norway provided financial assistance amounting to NOK 356 million in 2020. Supported activities included survey and clearance, victim assistance and mine risk education in more than 20 countries. The assistance is channeled through INGOs such as ICRC, MAG, the Halo Trust, Humanity and Inclusion, and Norwegian Peoples Aid, as well as through local NGOs addressing local needs. Norwegian commitment to mine action has been a key pillar of our international humanitarian efforts for many years, including in the current humanitarian strategy 2019-2023 (Strategi for norsk humanitær politikk – handlekraft og helhetlig innsats)
