Clarifications No. 1

Request for Proposal No. 19/2006/CPA91133 - Provision of Transport and Warehouse Insurance to the OSCE

The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (the OSCE) has received the request for clarifications from potential bidder with regard to RFP No. 19/2006/CPA91133.

In accordance with paragraph 8 “Clarification of Bidding Documents” of Section I, the OSCE would like to provide the clarifications to the Bidding Documents as specified below:

Question 1:

Potential bidder requested to inform of types of the goods normally transported.

Answer to Question 1:

The following types of the goods are mainly transported:

- IT equipment (e.g. computers, servers, printers and consumables, etc.)
- Communications equipment (e.g. VHF radios, satellite phones, fax machines)
- Motor vehicles and spare parts
- Books and other print materials
- Clothing

On several occasions some shipments of hazardous goods (class 1-9) have been made.

Question 2:

Potential bidder requested to inform whether the method of transportation is by road.

Answer to Question 2:

The OSCE uses all types of transportation (road, railway, air, sea).

Question 3:

Potential bidder requested to inform whether the OSCE owns the listed warehouses.

Answer to Question 3:

The OSCE does not own the warehouses but rent them from local companies. For example, the warehouse in Vienna is located in the bonded area which is a restricted customs controlled part of main warehouse which belongs to Kuehne & Nagel GesmbH.
