Right of Reply to the Russian Federation on Ukraine

As delivered by Chargé d'Affaires Courtney Austrian to the Permanent Council, Vienna April 15, 2021

Thank you very much, Madam Chair.

I would like to start by saying that I appreciate the participation of our Russian colleague today and I for one welcome the opportunity for a dialogue. Referring to some of the things that our esteemed colleague brought up, I would like to say that NATO has acted in a responsible, transparent, measured, and open manner in the context of significant uncertainty in the region caused by Russian actions. I believe it's Moscow that needs to meaningfully and immediately deescalate and do so in a transparent and verifiable way.

If Russia has concerns about NATO or U.S. forces in Europe, it should use the appropriate provisions of the *Vienna Document* to request additional information or transparency. I think we would be more than happy to answer any questions that my Russian colleague might have. Thank you very much.
