<p><b>15:30-18:00</b></p>	<p><b>SESSION I</b></p> <p><b>The illicit drugs market on the Internet and challenges to combat it</b></p> <p>Keynote speakers and participants will share information on current trends in the supply of illicit drugs such as heroin, cocaine, cannabis, synthetic drugs, and the diversion of precursor chemicals in the OSCE area on the Internet, including modes of website hosting, connections between buyers and sellers, and means of delivery of purchased items. They will raise awareness of the risks and threats posed by the online trade of illicit drugs and controlled substances. They will discuss the efforts of law enforcement agencies on operational response to prevent illicit drug supply through the Internet, measures undertaken by the participating States and assistance of the private sector in this endeavour. They will exchange information and best practices on new investigative methods for combating the illicit drugs market on the Internet.
