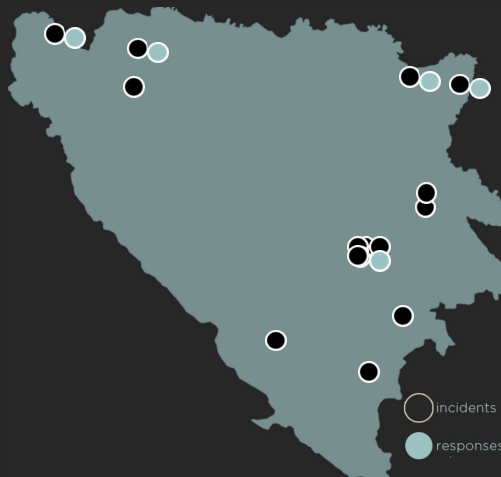

In January, the Mission recorded a number of responses to and condemnations of the increased occurrence of potential hate crimes and bias-related incidents. A significant number of local authorities, religious community and CSO representatives raised their voices against such occurrences, calling for dialogue and mutual respect.
