 - ✓ Increase the number of victims of trafficking who institute civil action, witness or injured party, in a criminal case;
 - ✓ Increase the level of participation of victims of trafficking in the prosecutorial stages and the criminal trial;
 - ✓ Monitor the observance of the victim's rights throughout all phases of the trial:
 - ✓ Inform victims about the applicable court and administrative proceedings;
 - ✓ Offer trafficked victims coming into contact with the investigative bodies information about the services they can apply to for specialized assistance;

During 2007, out of the total number of **837** victims initially evaluated by the regional centers, **808 victims** accepted to participate as injured parties or witnesses in trial.
