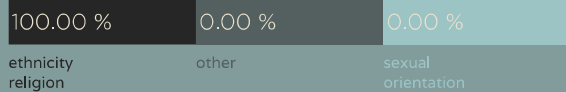

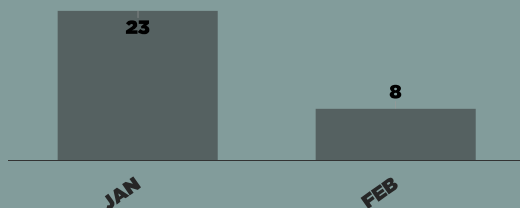

In February, for the first time Livno City Council adopted a Community Cohesion Action Plan.
