## High-Level Discussion on "Promoting the Role of Women in Addressing Environment and Security Challenges"

Vienna, 05 July 2019 Venue: Neuer Saal, Hofburg Conference Centre

The increasing frequency and intensity of natural disasters and extreme weather events, the growing demand for and competition over access to natural resources, and environmental degradation pose a series of challenges to sustainable development, economic progress and security and stability. In addressing these challenges, the different and specific capacities and vulnerabilities of women and men need to be taken into account.

The 2003 Maastricht OSCE Strategy Document for the Economic and Environmental Dimension provides a comprehensive framework for addressing linkages between environment and security. Furthermore, several other OSCE Ministerial Council Decisions and Declarations, including the 2007 Madrid Declaration on Environment and Security, and the 2014 Basel Ministerial Council Decision on Enhancing Disaster Risk Reduction acknowledge linkages between environment, disaster risk reduction and security, and demonstrate the commitment of the OSCE participating States to further strengthen co-operation aiming at reducing environment- and disaster-related security risks, with the latter specifically taking into consideration impacts on most vulnerable groups, including women.

The half-day high level discussion will bring together leading practitioners at national and international level to reflect on the impacts of environmental challenges on women and how to integrate a gender perspective in environmental planning and decision-making. The event aims to raise awareness among participating States on linkages between environment and security through an integrated gender perspective, while providing examples of good practices from the OSCE region and beyond.
